TRAINS

I continue to put new train timetables in the shops and in the Memorial Hall. The two train companies with trains that stop at King's Sutton, Chiltern Railways and Great Western Railway, have both reasonably good records for reliability and punctuality.

Some commuters have expressed concern about the lack of parking spaces, particularly in the early part of the week.

BUSES

We lost the 499 bus service at the end of July 2018.

South Northamptonshire District Council have to provide bus transport for our 11 – 16 year old children to school. Anyone over 16 requiring transport at that time can pay SNDC for a travel voucher to use on that bus.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT BUS PASSES

Any King's Sutton resident born before 5th January 1954 is entitled to a bus pass. They can be obtained or renewed at a Northamptonshire library or on line at the Northamptonshire County Council website.
