

## 2014 King's Sutton Way Ahead Village Survey – Preliminary Report

The King's Sutton Way Ahead campaign was launched as a parish-wide initiative in February last year, largely in reaction to unwanted housing developments in the village. The aim of the campaign was (and still is) to enable local residents to gain more control over their community's future by delivering evidence of local opinion in support of the district council's Local Plan and to provide a Village Design Statement that might eventually form the basis of a Neighbourhood Plan.

A comprehensive survey of village opinion was conducted in Spring/summer 2014 as part of the Way Ahead campaign, and a team of volunteers has since then been collating the 472 valid responses from individual residents ready for analysis. The King's Sutton Way Ahead Steering Group would first of all like to thank everyone in the village who made the effort to complete the survey. We knew that such a lengthy document – a huge number of questions squeezed into four, tightly-packed A4 pages – would put off a lot of people but we were pleasantly surprised that so many of our fellow residents had the patience to see the job through. That over a quarter of the parish's adult population did so provides a very clear indication of the level of local concern there is about the future of our beautiful area. (To put this level of response into perspective, only a few more people, just 30% of the electorate, turned out to vote in the last County Council election, when all that was required from them was to mark a single cross on the ballot paper!)

There is still much work to do on the analysis of the survey results. For example, we cannot as yet determine whether the demographics of our survey respondents – their age, sex, social class, etc – provide a reasonably close fit with the demographics of the parish's population as a whole. We will also need to determine what weighting is given to respondents' opinions according to other factors. For example, we might expect residents living at the outer edges of the village to favour infilling rather than new housing developments that spoil the views of open countryside they have enjoyed to date. For the moment, then, we are focusing in this report on revealing the percentage of respondents' views on specific aspects of village life and, apart from a few bulleted comments, are mostly leaving readers to draw their own conclusions. A full report on the survey results will be made available when the first draft of the intended King's Sutton Way Ahead Village Design Statement becomes available.

#### **Attitudes to Housing Development**

- Over three guarters of respondents think traditional style building is important
- Only just over 10% of respondents are in favour of South Northants Homes' plans for Astrop Grange
- Despite only 15 households reporting a member having to move because local housing was too expensive, over half of respondents want to see more "affordable" (ie, social) housing in King's Sutton
- The majority of respondents are in favour of the conversion of redundant building for housing, while just over 35% are happy to see infilling with 1-4 houses. Just over a quarter would find expansion on the edge of the village acceptable.
