ROSE GARDEN, CEMETERY, MILL LANE, KING'S SUTTON

GUIDELINES 2015/2016

- 1. Description: The name of the Rose Garden shall be the Jubilee Rose Garden. It comprises 2 raised planting beds enclosed with railway sleepers in the Old Section of the Cemetery on the place where formerly the War Memorial stood. Each raised bed is divided into 18 plots. Each plot shall be numbered and shall contain one rose. No other planting shall be permitted.
- 2. Purpose: To provide the opportunity to purchase the Exclusive Right to place an engraved numbered plaque corresponding to the same numbered rose plot in memory of an individual or individuals. No vases, objects or other artefacts shall be permitted in the Rose Garden.
- 3. Duration: The Exclusive Right to place one engraved plaque shall endure for 25 years.
- 4. Tariff: £98.00 per Exclusive Right to include: Certificate of Exclusive Right to place a plaque, rose, engraved plaque.
- 5. Engraving: Each plaque shall be engraved with a plot number and the words: Dedicated to *name(s)* and date. No additional names shall be added
- 6. Maintenance: The King's Sutton Parish Council shall maintain the Rose Garden and maintain and update the record of the Exclusive Rights.
- 7. Replacements: The King's Sutton Parish Council shall have responsibility for the rose, the commemorative brass plaque and wooden stake for the first five years. Thereafter, any loss, removal or wear and tear of either the rose, plaque or stake shall be to the account of the Grantee of the Exclusive Right. A replacement stake and plaque shall be available through the Parish Office for a charge in the sum of £40.00.
- 8. Pre Purchase: The Exclusive Right may not be purchased in advance.
